### **STATIONARY LIST FOR GRADE 7 for 2020**

**Each child must have his/her own stationary, which is replenished every term.**

1 x Space case/pencil bag.

3 x Blue Bic pens – no gel or fine liners.

3 x Black Bic pens – no gel or fine liners.

3 x HB Staedtler pencils or clutch pencils (own lead).

1 x 12 Staedtler colouring pencils.

1 x sharpener with a container (to catch sharpening's).

2 x 40g Pritt glue sticks (Only white Pritt).

1 x 30cm ruler in cm and mm (Hard plastic).

1 x Scissors (Staedtler).

1 x Eraser (Staedtler – soft).

2 x Boxes of tissues. (To be handed in on the first day of school).

1 x Set of ball point (not gel or fine liners) coloured ink pens (Staedtler).

4 x High lighters (Different colours – not wax).

Sellotape: 1 x Thin for covering.

Sellotape: 1 x Broad, clear rolls for fixing of books. (Please send to school on the first day).

Thick plastic to cover textbooks and workbooks (50mic).

2 x Flip file (30 page).

1 x Mathematical set (Oxford, Croxley or Marlin).

1 x Calculator (Casio or Sharp).

1 x Packet wet wipes (**To be handed in on first day of school**).

1 x A4 80gsm (50 sheets) assorted bright colour **paper** pad (Butterfly – to be handed in)

### **IMPORTANT:**

- \* Stationary kept by pupils must be at school every day.
- \* No tippex.
- \* **NO** borrowing from friends will be allowed.
- \* Do not send plastic and 1 x thin sellotape to school – teachers do not cover books for pupils.
- \* Clothes, shoes, trainers, stationary and school bags need to be marked clearly.
- \* Collect cereal boxes. It is very useful when textbooks need to be fixed. - Please send the cereal boxes to school as you collect them during the year.
- \* When the textbooks are sent home in the beginning of the year, please ensure that they are properly fixed and strengthen to last for the rest of the year.
